

Registering Revealing ... When Running from the CD with Data on a Zip Disk (Windows)

NOTE: This is the likely scenario if you are working on a university computer or another computer that is not your own. Please note that most universities will routinely delete anything that students place on the server or local hard drives, so, you MUST have a Zip disk on which to store your data. A floppy disk is too small. If your computer lab is equipped with CD-RW drives, rather than Zip drives, a CD-RW will work.

1. You will need both the Revealing Archaeology CD and a blank formatted Zip disk.
2. Place both the CD and the Zip disk in the appropriate drives.
3. Launch Revealing Archaeology from the CD by doing the following:
 - A. Double-click on My Computer.
 - B. Double-click on the Revealing Archaeology CD.
 - C. Double-click on the Revealing Archaeology folder.
 - D. Double-click on Revealing Archaeology.exe (Depending on the settings on the computer you are using, you might not see the ".exe". It is the one with the orange icon with the gear.)
4. The FIRST time you run Revealing Archaeology, you will need to register your software. So, on the first screen you see, click the REGISTER button.
5. On the next screen, choose to Store Your Data On A Zip Disk (the big blue button on the right).
6. Click the BROWSE button.
7. A Window will open in which you will need to Browse or Navigate to your Zip disk. You select the Zip disk from the pull-down menu that is usually at the bottom of the little gray and white window that opens.
8. Once you have selected the Zip disk and see it in the top white space of the little Window, press OK.
9. A message will appear telling you where your RA_UserData is being stored. Check that this is correct and then click the okay button.
10. PLEASE WAIT PATIENTLY as files are copied from the CD to your Zip disk.
11. The registration screens will appear. You need an ACTIVE INTERNET CONNECTION during the registration process. Please fill in all of the information accurately. To ensure that you will receive receipts from your

instructor's Interactive Grade Book, it is best to use your university email address, rather than an AOL or Hotmail address.

12. When you click the Check box to complete the registration process, you will need to wait a few moments as your software is registered. After you click the Continue button, some other files may be updated and copied to your Zip disk. When that is finished, click the final Continue button.

13. You will see your Achievement Profile.
