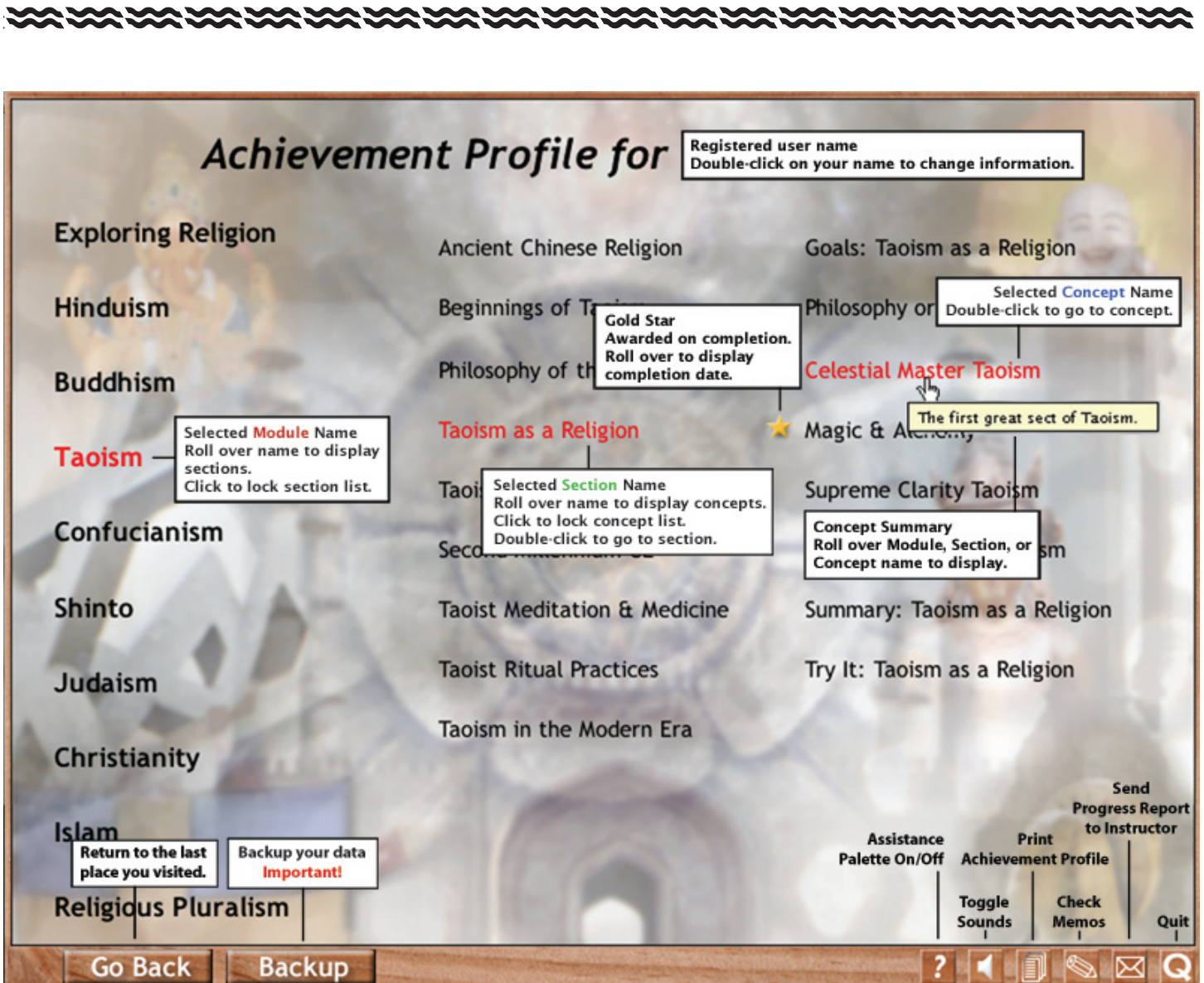


# Revealing<sup>®</sup> World Religions

Helpful Hints: Page 1 of 2



The illustration above shows the Achievement Profile from Revealing<sup>®</sup> World Religions. The Achievement Profile serves two main purposes. It is the central navigational hub for *Revealing<sup>®</sup>* World Religions. It also keeps you abreast of your progress.

Navigate by moving your cursor over the module names in the left column. This reveals the list of sections that comprise each module. Click your mouse to lock

the list of section names, then roll over the section names to see the list of concepts that comprise each section. Click on a section name to lock the list of concepts. Double-click on either a section or a concept name to go there.

When you complete a concept, section, or module, your progress is reported in the form of gold stars that appear to the left of the item. Roll over the gold star to see the date you completed the item.

At the bottom left of the screen are buttons that allow you to return quickly to the last place you visited, and backup your progress information. At the bottom right are buttons that let you control sound, access the Assistance Palette, go to your memos page, send your progress reports to your instructor, and quit the program.

Take a few minutes to review these features, and you'll be off!

**Zhang Lu** — Page Title  
The page title is displayed in the Assistance Palette under the Recent and Search functions.

After Zhang Daoling's death, his grandson, Zhang Lu, inherited control over the Taoist sect Zhang Daoling had developed. Zhang Lu declared that his grandfather had been the celestial master promised in Taoist scripture. He continued the process of constructing Celestial Master Taoism on that basis, spreading it throughout central China.

**Celestial Master Taoism:** A school of Taoism founded in 142 CE by Zhang Daoling, who claimed that Laozi appeared to him. Zhang Daoling is considered the first Celestial Master.

Body Text  
This text can be searched with the Search tab in the Assistance Palette. Print the text with the button on the control bar at the bottom of the screen.

Background Image  
Alt-click (Windows) or option-click (Mac) on background to reveal image and caption.

Context-sensitive glossary  
If the cursor changes to a pointing finger when you roll over a word, click to display a definition. Click anywhere to clear the definition.

Click the star to return to Achievement Profile. If the star is gold, you've completed this page. If the star is white, you have more to do.

Click the up arrow to navigate to another module or section
